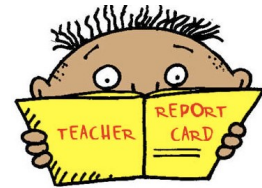

Students should come to school well dressed for the weather.

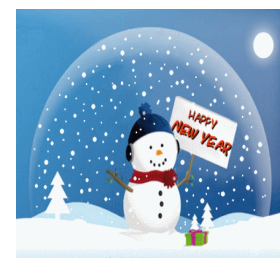
Please ensure your child has a winter coat, snow pants, hat, winter boots and mittens.
