If your family is dealing with cost pressures, the school can access these funds to support your child with food security or other affordability concerns. We are using this funding by having a fruit/veggie bowl in each classroom that students can access if they want an extra, whole school Friday snack is back and 'Lunch is on Us', where we supply lunch to all students once a month.

Check out the calendar to see all the important events happening at Nicholson in the month of February such as the Winter Festival - February 10th, 100's day - February 15th, Pink Shirt Day - February 22nd as well as a Non-Instruction Day (no school) on February 13th and Family Day on February 20th.
