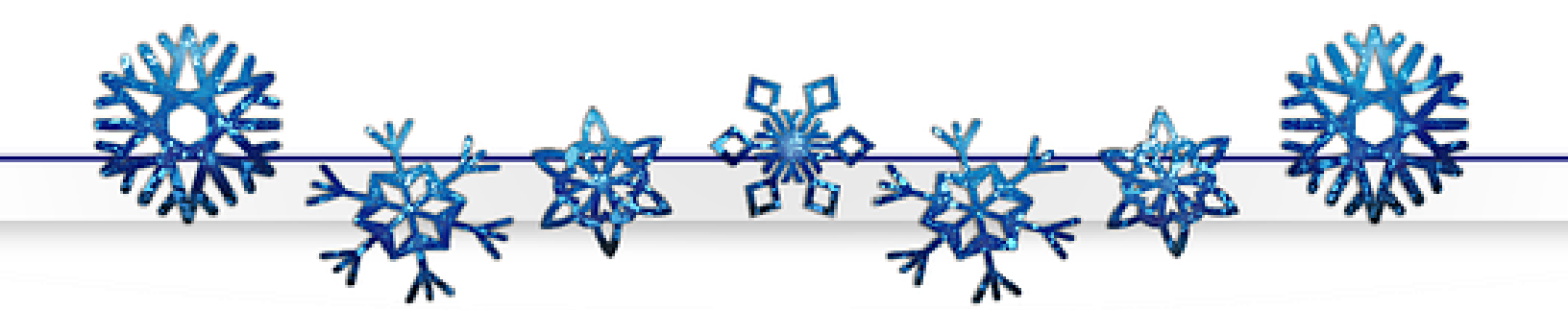
Nicholson Elementary is a welcoming, happy place to be.
