What is an Emergency Contact?

Parents will always be our first contact (don't add yourselves)

<u>Emergency contacts</u> can be neighbors, friends, other school parents and relatives in our area is preferred.

Why do we need to do this each year?

We do not have access to LAST years emergency contacts, so it is so important to list everyone who can pick up your child from school in cases of illness, missed buses or other school emergencies.

Personal Technology

We ask that students put any personal technology devices into their backpacks from the time they enter school property, until they leave school property. They are not to be left in clothing pockets or their desk. Students are not to use any personal technology devices during lunch or recess. <u>Morning Drop Off:</u> Please drop bottom of the stairs, no earlier than 8:30am, children are to walk around the school and **not through the parking lot**.

<u>Late students</u>: Please come in the front door and let the office know they have arrived.

Please remember to call the office if your child will be away ie: sick, holidays, appointments or going to be late. Sometimes sicknesses may go on for a few days, please remember to call each day, or send an email. The Administrative Assistant will be calling if your child hasn't been accounted for.

<u>Dropping off lunch or backpack</u>: Please bring it to the front office and not to the classroom.

<u>Picking up your child for an appointments or illness:</u> Feel free to park in the designated handicap parking spot beside the schools front door. <u>You must come to the front office for pick up.</u> Children are not let out to meet at the bottom the stairs.

<u>After school pick up:</u> If your child is being picked up by someone other than the regular pick up person, please let the office and or teacher know.


